Dear Terry

As a resident of Faversham and the surrounding areas I am very concerned about the traffic management plan and specifically the volume of traffic and large vehicles occupying our small country roads and the effect this will have on cyclists and other road users.

Head Hill Road into Seasalter Road is already a dangerous route for pedestrians and cyclists, and will become even more so with this proposed development. There is a primary school, lots of housing and many young families, to name a few significantly affected groups. At no stage have there been proposals to address their safety.

I believe the proposed Solar Cycleway / Community Corridor will mitigate accidents and threat by providing a safe alternative for pedestrians and cyclists.

As such, I urge you to engage with and consider the solar cycleway / community corridor proposal as a serious and sensible addition to the management of the traffic associated with the development.
